Dr. Hernandez currently leads emergency medicine content development and solutions delivery at Sg2, a health care consulting firm. He analyzes the strategic, operational and technology adoption opportunities at client organizations to improve access and patient throughput.

A seasoned clinician, he has served as chairman and medical director of a high-acuity urban emergency department, and continues to participate in medical student and resident physician education.
